Responsibilities and Expectations of a Servant/Leader:

The following is the list of attributes of a leader, found in 1 Timothy 3:1-13 and Titus 1:5-9. The Lead Team is accountable to living a lifestyle consistent with these things while being open and receiving grace in their failures. Servant Team members are asked to be growing in these areas, and are also invited to help keep the Lead Team accountable to these things (with an attitude of truth and love).

Be above reproach (so good that criticism cannot be made)
Sexually pure
Prudent, sensible, wise
Respectable
Hospitable
Not addicted to alcohol, following the laws and being wise in it's use
(no alcohol use if under 21, no drunkenness)
Good reputation with unbelievers
Temperate, not quarrelsome, aggressive, quick-tempered
Gentle, Peaceable
Free from the love of money, not materialistic
Manage your own personal life well, good relationships
Not a gossip
Loving what is good, just
Faithful, devout
Self-controlled, not self-willed
Holding fast to God's word, able to use it correctly to teach and correct
